Job Description

Position Summary

Under general supervision of the Recreation Coordinator provides training and instruction of youth and adults participating in the City of Hurricane Karate Program.

Supervision Received

Works under the general supervision of the Fine Arts Coordinator and the Recreation Director.

- Assists in the training and instruction of participants in basic karate techniques to provide
 a quality competitive environment to train and motivate young athletes and adults in the
 sport of karate; instructs karate team participants on safe karate techniques and physical
 training regimens.
- Assists in organizing and coordinating karate team practices and physical workouts. May assist in recording attendance.
- Assists in setting up and taking down equipment and preparing venue for activities and events; Assist in conducting karate classes for different age groups; instructs and coaches participants; maintains equipment and facilities in clean and safe condition.
- Assists in monitoring karate activities during training and practices; recommends
 performances of program participants to Instructor and explains techniques and assists
 with skills improvement.
- Monitors guests and program participants and enforces rules, regulations, and safety
 precautions at facilities; maintains discipline, monitors behavior, and resolves issues;
 monitors program activities, and assists participants in karate activities and programs.
- Promotes a positive recreation environment and good personal behavior; explains to public, community resource agencies, and other organizations about program activities.
- Prevents accidents through the enforcement of policies, rules, regulations, and ordinances governing the conduct of karate patrons; monitors activities in the facilities for individuals who may need assistance or guidance.

 Administers first aid to the injured and calls Emergency Medical Services (EMS) on serious accident cases.

Minimum Qualifications

Qualifications, Education and Experience

- Minimum of (1-2) years of successful experience in teaching dance to youth or adults.
- High School diploma or GED equivalent; AND two years' experience in conducting, organizing and instructing karate programs.

Required Licenses or Certifications:

- Must possess certificates for First Aid and CPR. Required to submit to a background investigation.
- Must be certified as a Black Belt and show certification and references or be in training under a certified Black Belt.
