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## Job Description

### Position Summary

Incumbents in this position are responsible for performing a variety of entry level, semi-skilled duties related to the mowing and maintenance of golf course greens, tees, roughs and fairways. This is a part-time position consisting of approximately 28 hours per week. Applicants may be required to work extended or irregular hours such as weekends, nights and holidays.

### Supervision Received

Works under the general supervision of the Golf Course Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent.

**Essential Functions** (Essential functions, as defined under the Americans with Disabilities Act, may include the following tasks, knowledge, skills, and other characteristics. The list of tasks is illustrative only and is not a comprehensive listing of all functions and tasks performed by positions in this class.)

- Operates heavy equipment such as fairway mowers, rough mowers, sprayers, spreaders and other utility vehicles as directed.
- Operates light equipment such as sod cutters, walking rotary mowers, line trimmers, edgers, blowers, rollers and walking aerifiers as directed.
- Grades and prepares soil for seed, sod, plants or trees. Lays sod and plants vegetative materials.
- Aerates and top-dresses greens, tees, fairways and other areas in need of repair.
- Assists with the installation and servicing of irrigation and drainage systems and hand waters if necessary.
- Performs general maintenance and repair on all grounds and any course facility or building.
- Mows, verticuts, aerifies and top-dresses greens, tees, fairways and roughs.
- Repairs turf, cuts and clean up uncontrolled weeds.
- Monitors general condition of the golf course.
- Picks up garbage, maintains water coolers as well as rake and groom bunkers.
- Performs golf course set up and other related duties as required.

### Typical Physical/Mental Demands/Working Conditions

Incumbent of the position performs moderate physical activity. Required to push, pull or lift medium heavy weights. May have uncomfortable working positions such as stooping, crouching and bending. Moderate exposure to elements such as heat, cold dampness, fumes, noise, dust or grease. May have disagreeable elements such as appearance of work place, poor ventilation or uneven temperatures. Occupational safety and health

hazards may be encountered under controlled conditions. Some exposure to hazardous materials such as fumes, pesticides, cleaning agents, etc. High levels of noise. Function within construction areas, trenches and confined spaces. Exposure to stress as a result of human behavior. Requires working extended or irregular hours such as weekends, nights and holidays.

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### **Minimum Qualifications**

#### **Qualifications, Education and Experience:**

1. Possess a valid Utah Driver's License throughout employment.

#### **Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities**

- Basic English composition, spelling, grammar and computer skills.
- Knowledge of tools, equipment and techniques used in maintenance, landscapes, irrigation systems and hardscapes which may include basic construction projects.
- Knowledge of standard safety procedures and precautions relating to equipment operations and the loading and unloading of materials.
- Operation of a variety of hand tools and equipment common to landscape trades.
- Ability to operate gang mowers, fairway mowers, rough mowers, and other utility vehicles.
- Perform outdoor manual labor for extended periods of time.
- Perform various semi-skilled and skilled functions related to building and landscape maintenance.
- Develop effective working relationships with supervisors, subordinates and the public.
