The term nuisance applies to any condition or use of the property which is harmful, injurious or unsightly. This may include, but not limited to, the storing or scattering over the property any of the following: lumber, junk, trash/debris, discarded or unused objects or equipment such as automobiles, furniture, appliances, containers or unused machinery or other discarded items not currently in use. Nuisance ordinances do not regulate aesthetics.

Weeds constitute a nuisance when they create a danger to health, are a fire hazard, create a breeding ground for insects or vermin.

A list of items that may be determined to be a nuisance, as well as the process established for investigating and prosecuting a nuisance, may be obtained by requesting a copy of Hurricane City Code 4-2.

Any determination of a nuisance is at the discretion of the Code Enforcement Officer.
