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HURRICANE CITY 3 YEAR TRAINING & EXERCISE PLAN 2010

As an active member of the Southwest Region (IV) and Washington County, the City of Hurricane is committed to maintaining a training and exercise program that will prepare Hurricane City employees and volunteers to respond to a situation as necessary. The City of Hurricane is an active member of the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) and works closely with other Emergency Response Providers throughout the region and the State.

Through the use of ICS Specific Training, the City of Hurricane with Chief Lynn L Excell as the Emergency Management Coordinator has established the following goals for the City in order to improve communication, collaboration and support between responding professionals and volunteers.

1. TRAINING

- A. Complete the Advanced Professional Series for members of the Police Department, Fire Department, and Emergency Management Team.
- B. Complete ICS-400 training for management personnel within all City departments.
- C. Establish a CERT Team and provide training for CERT members.
- D. Provide ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-700, & ICS-800 courses for those in the Region.
- E. Continue with G courses that will benefit the community.
- F. Train elected & appointed officials on an annual basis. Provide this training to the Region.
- G. Apply for and attend one (1) course at EMI per year.

2. EXERCISE

- A. Perform a tabletop and functional exercises with City Staff and Community Emergency Responders.
- B. Conduct Special Events that utilize ICS and NIMS requirements, approx. 10 per year.
- C. Full-scale exercise involving all communities within the county – private partners & regional entities.
- D. All exercises will involve NIMS, ICS, & Unified Command.

The current proposed training and exercise schedule is as follows:

2010 – Conduct a real event: Full scale Ironman Triathlon in May 2010

2011 and 2012 – Work with Region IV and State T & E to develop training and exercises that include earthquake response.
