Minutes

### Business:

1. The minutes for January 2015 were approved.
2. Lucy informed us that an anonymous donor has purchased a trailer for our trail-building/maintenance supplies. It is being stored at Quentin's bike shop.
3. Dave is in charge of the work day for Saturday, February 21<sup>st</sup> to remove the trash piles below the dump in Confluence Park. He and Quentin are also scheduled to coordinate a work project on the H-Connector trail on Monday evening March 9<sup>th</sup> at 6pm. Quentin told Lucy he will make sure parking is available.
4. Lucy reported on her meeting with the Confluence Park Committee: One building with a Kiosk and toilet is still the current plan. Nina Fitzgerald will do a narrative for the sign. Construction is supposed to start soon.
5. There is no new information regarding the Virgin River Overlook Trail by Grandpa's Pond.
6. Lucy asked what our main goals should be for this year. Jeff suggested prioritizing what we would like to accomplish. Our main interest is advocacy for our Master Plan and we would like to be informed about new building projects in the city so we can hopefully encourage the city to stick to the plan. We will discuss our priorities at our next meeting.
