

Hurricane City Trails Committee

May 20, 2015
Minutes

Committee members in attendance: Lucy Ormond, Darin Thomas, Jason Ward, Rachel DeBoer

Business:

1. The minutes for April 2015 were approved.
2. Rachel reported on the Hurricane Safety Fair sponsored by and located at Lin's Market on 5-16-15. She handed out flyers promoting the Road Respect Event to the families and scout troops attending.
3. Lucy updated us on the Road Respect Event on Friday, May 29, 2015 at the Community Center in Hurricane. The 27 mile bike ride will begin at 7:30am followed by the helmet give-away to the first 100 kids attending with adults at 9am. The Police Department will then do their Safety Rodeo. At 9:15am the Mayor of Hurricane will be presented with the Road Respect designation for the city. At 10:30am, the 1 mile kids bicycle ride will begin. Following the ride, at about 11am, the drawing will be held for two kids bicycles.
4. Lucy reported that she talked with Dave Kiel from the BLM regarding the Cinder Knolls trails and he told her they are still in the decision-making process.
5. Per Lucy, Quentin is still working with volunteers on the H-Connector trail. No report this evening from him. Per Lucy, Dave is planning a work project for a trail at Sand Hollow on Saturday, May 30, at 9am with the LDS Young Adults. Lucy will attend and supervise their trail-building efforts.
6. Lucy was approached by Jack LaDuke, a resident of Sky Mountain, regarding a 2 mile trail he is interested in developing around the golf course in that community. He would need approval to make it happen. He will take a survey of the residents of the community to see if there is enough interest to move forward.
7. Lucy reported on her meeting with the Confluence Park committee. The Hurricane Main Street trail head has been staked out for the restroom with water and electricity to be brought in soon. They estimate 6-8 weeks to completion.
8. Our newest committee member, Jeff Olsen, who has been a great help to us, is in the Army Reserves and has informed Lucy that he has been put on active duty orders and will be deployed soon for 9-14 months. We are sad to see him leave but wish him well in his service to our country. Lucy asked us to think about citizens we might be able to recruit to help us on the committee. Any suggestions should be emailed to her. She'll talk with the Mayor about any suggestions he might have.
9. Due to the upcoming travel plans of committee members for the next few months, we will not meet in June, July or August.
