Minutes

Business:

1. The minutes for May 2015 were approved.
2. Lucy gave a brief overview of what our committee has accomplished in recent years to the scouts and leaders. They are attending our meeting to fulfill a requirement for a merit badge and will possibly help with some service projects in the future.
3. Per Lucy, Quentin is 65% done with the the H-Connector Trail. He needs more volunteers to help finish. He would like to have a Scout commit to an Eagle project for a bridge that needs to be built. He could supply the scout with expertise on how to proceed as well as help him procure all tools necessary. Wes said the scout leader for older boys in this area, Brett Dennett, is looking for Eagle Scout projects. Lucy will call him and give him Quentin's information if they want to contact him for a project. Lucy will also contact Quentin to see if he wants to set up a volunteer work day.
4. Jason will check with the BLM to see if the Cinder Knolls Trails show up on any of their proposals.
5. Lucy joined Dave Wilkey and approximately 30 LDS Young Adult volunteers for a work day on Saturday, May 30th. They built a trail with cairns on slick rock on the west side of the golf course at Sand Hollow. They also did some trash clean-up.
6. Lucy reported that the trail head for Confluence Park on the Hurricane side now has a restroom. No signs are up yet and the parking lot still needs to be graded. The restroom will not open until all work is completed and the trail head dedicated. Lucy will find out at the Confluence Park October meeting when they are planning the dedication. We will want to organize a maintenance work day before the dedication.
7. Lucy met with Marcie DeMillion and Ken Richley of RTCA in Salt Lake City. They suggested we use our Master Trail Plan as a marketing tool to encourage the Mayor and City Council to float a bond to fully develop the main trails on the already approved plan. Lucy will talk with Clark Faucett to see how we can possibly proceed to make this happen. This will be our main objective in the future along with scheduling work days for trail-building projects and trail maintenance.
