

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HURRICANE, UTAH,
ESTABLISHING RATES FOR CONSTRUCTION WATER SUPPLIED THROUGH
CITY FIRE HYDRANTS**

WHEREAS the Hurricane City Water Department supplies water to developers for construction, which water is supplied through the City’s fire hydrants;

WHEREAS the Hurricane City Water Board has recommended an increase to \$3.00 per thousand gallons to Hurricane City’s billing rates for this construction water;

WHEREAS the Hurricane City Council finds that an increase in the billing rates for this construction water is necessary to bring the rates in line with the actual costs and impacts of supplying the water;


WHEREAS the Hurricane City Council finds it necessary and desirable for the preservation and protection of health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Hurricane

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of Hurricane, Utah as follows:

1. The billing rate for construction water shall be \$3.00 per thousand gallons.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect as the earliest date allowed by law.
