

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HURRICANE, UTAH, ADOPTING
THE 2022 FIVE COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS MULTI-
JURISDICTIONAL NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.**

WHEREAS Hurricane City has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the 2022 Five County Association of Governments Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS the 2022 Five County Association of Governments Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Hurricane City from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS adoption by the City Council demonstrates their commitment to the hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2022 Five County Association of Governments Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan.
