

AN ORDINANCE OF HURRICANE CITY, UTAH TEMPORARILY CLOSING THE ROAD AT THE INTERSECTION OF 1515 W AND 200 SOUTH

WHEREAS the City Council of Hurricane, Utah, has authority under Utah Code Section 72-5-105 to temporarily close a class C road; and

WHEREAS the roads within Hurricane City designated as 200 South and 1515 West constitute class C roads under the Utah Code; and

WHEREAS the City Council of Hurricane, Utah has determined that the connection between 200 South and 1515 West is not necessary at this time, provided that emergency vehicles will continue to have access through an approved gate; and

WHEREAS this portion of 200 South is only partially constructed and provides limited access; and

WHEREAS the City Council of Hurricane, Utah has determined that temporarily closing the City road at the intersection of 200 South and 1515 West is necessary to (1) mitigate unsafe conditions and (2) mitigate injury to private and public land resources; and

WHEREAS the City Council of Hurricane, Utah has determined it will not be detrimental to the preservation of the general health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Hurricane City to temporarily close the City road at the intersection of 200 South and 1515 West; and

WHEREAS proper notice of this action has been duly provided and a public hearing has been duly held,

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the City Council of Hurricane, Utah that the City road at the intersection of 200 South and 1515 West shall be temporarily closed by placing in the roadway a gate that is approved for emergency vehicle access. This temporary road closure shall continue until such time as the City Council of Hurricane, Utah determines that the gate shall be removed and the roadway opened to the public.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall, upon adoption, take effect at the earliest date possible after posting or publication as required by law.
