

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HURRICANE, UTAH, APPOINTING THE HONORABLE MATTHEW CARLING AS A TEMPORARY JUSTICE COURT JUDGE FOR THE HURRICANE JUSTICE COURT

WHEREAS, the Hurricane Justice Court currently operates with one judge; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code 78A-7-208 permits the appointment of judges from other jurisdictions to serve as temporary justice court judges when the City Council determines it is necessary; and

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that the City Council appoint an eligible temporary judge to allow maximum flexibility in dealing with any necessary absences or recusals of the regular judge; and

WHEREAS, Judge Matthew Carling is presently qualified and is serving as an Iron County Justice Court Judge; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that we, the City Council of Hurricane, Utah, do hereby appoint as a temporary justice court judge The Honorable Matthew Carling to serve in the absence of the sitting judge.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
