

RESOLUTION

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HURRICANE, UTAH, APPROVING
A TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATION BALANCE BETWEEN DEPARTMENTS IN
THE SAME FUND**

WHEREAS, the City Council of Hurricane, Utah has authority under Utah Code Section 10-6-125 to transfer any unencumbered or unexpended appropriation balance or portion thereof from one department in a fund to another department within the same fund; and

WHEREAS, the Animal Control Capital Facility budget has an appropriation balance that qualifies to be transferred to the Police Department budget; and

WHEREAS, the Sky Mountain Golf Course Pro Shop budget has an appropriation balance that qualifies to be transferred to the Sky Mountain Golf Course Maintenance Operations budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary and desirable to transfer a portion of the Animal Control Capital Facility budget to the Police Department budget to match the County-wide police officer wage increase.; and

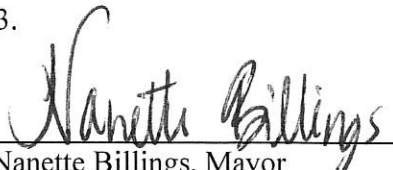
WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary and desirable to transfer a portion of the Sky Mountain Golf Course Pro Shop budget to the Sky Mountain Golf Course Maintenance Operations budget to adjust to the capital project needs of the Sky Mountain Golf Course;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of Hurricane, Utah that the necessary funds be transferred in the following manner:

1. From the Animal Control Capital Facility budget to the Police Department budget in an amount sufficient to match the County-wide police officer wage increase and
2. The Sky Mountain Golf Course Pro Shop budget to the Sky Mountain Golf Course Maintenance Operations budget to adjust to the capital project needs of the Sky Mountain Golf Course.
