

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HURRICANE, UTAH,
REAPPOINTING JOHN SLACK TO THE WATER BOARD

WHEREAS, Hurricane City has adopted Hurricane City Code 8-1-2: Water Board; and

WHEREAS, Hurricane City code requires the City Council to appoint a Water Board “consisting of nine members”, one of whom shall be an elected official from the city council, one of whom shall be the water superintendent, one of whom shall be the street superintendent, and one of whom shall be an appointed member of city staff. The remaining members shall be appointed by the mayor with the advice and consent of a majority of the remaining members of the city council at any meeting at which a quorum is present. The term of the elected official and city staff shall coincide with the term of elected office or employment; and

WHEREAS, the terms “of Water Board members shall begin on the first Monday in February of each year”; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, with advice and consent of the City Council, may reappoint current Water Board member to service for successive terms.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Hurricane City Council that John Slack shall be reappointed to Water Board for the following term:




