

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HURRICANE, UTAH, DECLARING A PROPOSED LAND ACQUISITION AS A VALID PUBLIC USE

WHEREAS, Hurricane City is a Utah public entity; and

WHEREAS, the Hurricane City Council desires to obtain parcel H-SMME-18 from the Utah Department of Transportation (“UDOT”) for the purpose of improving the connectivity of Hurricane City roadways; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of Parcel H-SMME-18, located at approximately 500 North and State Street, will facilitate a land exchange with a cooperating landowner whereby the City will acquire land for the extension of 500 North from State Street to 360 East Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is necessary and desirable for 500 North to extend through the intersection at State Street and connect to 360 East Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds the proposed use of the land qualifies as a valid public use,

BE IT HEREBY DECLARED by the City Council of Hurricane, Utah that the proposed acquisition of Parcel H-SMME-18 from UDOT qualifies as a valid public use pursuant to Utah Administrative Code R907-80-10.
