



Old Highway 91 - Improvements



Hurricane City continues improvements to the Old Hwy 91 Corridor from the intersection of SR-9 and continuing north for approximately 2.4 miles.

Crews will finish preparing the first section of the project today for asphalt paving on Monday. Crews will begin paving early in the morning. When this section of paving is finished, traffic will be shifted onto the new asphalt surface and work will begin to remove the asphalt and sub-grade on the other half of the road. It is anticipated, the second phase of asphalt paving will begin the week of April 11. The first section of the project is from the Old Hwy 91 and SR-9 intersection to the Associate entrance into the Walmart Distribution Center.

The second section will remove the existing asphalt surface from the Walmart Distribution entrance to the end of the project limits. (See map above) This phase will be done in thirds with crews starting on the northbound lane, moving to the southbound lane and then completing the upgrade in the center lane. Traffic shifts will occur throughout this improvement project.

There will be no on-street parking along Old Highway 91 at anytime during construction.

The project is estimated to be completed by the first of July 2022. Your patience is appreciated.
