



Old Highway 91 - Improvements



Monday, April 11, 2022 - Hurricane City continues improvements to the Old Hwy 91 Corridor from the intersection of SR-9 and continuing north for approximately 2.4 miles.

Crews finished paving the second phase and first section of the project this morning. A team will be uncovering manholes and water valves to place concrete collars and lids in the first section of the project over the coming week. Traffic patterns will be changing, but one lane is open in each direction along with accesses to properties throughout the project.

Work will begin on the second section of the project today where crews will remove the existing asphalt surface and subgrade from the Walmart Distribution entrance to the end of the project limits. (See map above) New structure material will be placed and compacted, and phase three is scheduled for paving on Monday, April 18.

Traffic shifts will occur throughout this improvement project. Please pay attention, stay in your lane of travel and observe the posted speed limit.

There will be no on-street parking along Old Highway 91 at anytime during construction.

The project is estimated to be completed by the first of July 2022. Your patience is appreciated. **Schedule is subject to weather and other unforeseen circumstances.*
